Ingela Ihrman First Came the Landscape, 2023 First Came the Landscape is a giant stick skeleton Main Entrance made from the trunk, limbs and branches of a North Gate single beech tree, blown down during Storm Eunice in 2022. The figure reflects the delicate cycle of life – a system of death and rebirth as things move from one form to another. It will remain here in this location until the pieces of wood - the pelvis, spine, femur, humerus and skull – naturally break down, returning back to the ground and benefitting the surrounding ecology of the earth as they decay.
